## **GUIDELINES**

### **Statement of Research Purpose (SoRP)**

The SoRP shall consist of the following in not more than 2000 words:

- Justification for the broad area of research
- Academic achievements
- Skills acquired
- Research achievements
- Publications
- Project/Internship experience

The SoRP provides inputs to the selection committee on the background, expertise, research interests and achievements of the candidate. The SoRP indicates the potential of the candidate for admission into the Programme.

### **Brief Research Proposal (BRP)**

Brief Research Proposal (BRP) shall indicate the focused area of research and proposed place of research. The BRP shall contain the following in not more than 1500 words:

- Proposed topic of research
- Objective of the proposed research
- Background of research
- Expected outcome

The BRP provides inputs to the selection committee on the knowledge and understanding of the applicant in the proposed area of research before proceeding to the technical interview.
